There are no large purchases this year to be made. What the school would like is the classroom level books. We purchased a 2nd grade set because an additional 2nd grade class was added this year. The teachers would like new dye cuts – what they have currently are really old and if money is available they have given us a list.

Questions on what the different line items are on the budget. Would be nice to have a definition of them. We answered the following:

Benevolence Fund – helps if a child is unable to pay for a field trip

<u>Buddy Program</u> – 5th/6th graders "buddy" up w/autism students – the funds are for toys, supplies, games, etc... use these items to interact w/one another.

<u>Take Home Reading</u> – aka "Chema" reading – additional books to help kids who need additional help w/reading.

- Movie License increase this line item because it goes up each year a little
- Directories price went down because now it will be on line

- New Superintendent Mr. Fee knows him and said is a good guy
- If we grow with more students, we may increase the classes per grade have some available rooms
- We are over capacity now by 60 students, so we are unable to accept more students not living in school area just because we are a good school
- VDOT says we can't get a "no left turn" sign in front of the school
- Looking at sending out a list of the do's and don'ts of parking/dropping off kids, etc...
- Renovation of playground we are still on the list, a little higher up now
- Butterfly Garden PLEASE don't pick the flowers
- Tarp for over the playground for sun protections not sure of any regulations, need to check to see if PTA could buy one and have County install it
